Why a
Dress Code?

We desire that all participants dress in such a way that honours God, themselves, and their fellow participants.

This dress code applies to all participants of any FacetoFace developed program/event. Participants and their parents are asked to read through the following dress code in its entirety and adhere to it for the duration of their FacetoFace Ministries Program.

Tops • Clothing displaying negative messages/imagery is **not** permitted. This includes messages/imagery that could be viewed as controversial.

*Whether or not clothing graphics are deemed acceptable is left to the discretion of the Event Director and the participants Small Group Leader.

- Sleeveless shirts must have straps at least 3 finger widths wide (measuring with the fingers of the person wearing the garment).
- Undershirts/tanks cannot be worn as the participants only top.
- Tanks with large arm cut outs are **not** permitted.
- T-shirts where sleeves have been cut off are **not** permitted.

Bottoms • Shorts must have an inseam of at least 7 inches. This inseam must be maintained even when the hem has been rolled up.

- Denim with intentional scuffing/stressing is permitted. Tears to jeans that show the participant's skin are **not** permitted.
- Bottoms must fully cover the participant's underwear including the underwear waistband.

Swimwear • Swim bottoms must have an inseam of 5" or more.

- Excessively tight-fitting bottoms are **not** permitted.
- When playing water games such as water balloon fights, male participants are asked to wear shirts. When at swimming pools, slip n' slides or other water environments where the participant will be submerged, shirts are not necessary.
- Participants must wear a shirt when transitioning to dorms/change area

Dormwear • Male participants must be fully dressed when outside of dorm room or bathroom. Loungewear is appropriate but a top and bottom must be worn.

- This applies for going between bathroom and dorm room for any reason.
- It is highly recommended that participants bring shower shoes as showers are shared between multiple dorm rooms
