4 IMPACTFUL PRAYER MOMENTS

Participants are led through tangible prayer moments where they are given the opportunity to encounter God and choose to say "yes" to the Holy Spirit at their Confirmation.

YOUR PARISH DESERVES A HIGH-QUALITY CONFIRMATION RETREAT

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHO WILL FACILITATE YOUR RETREAT?

FacetoFace ensures well-formed and dynamic retreat leaders (typically two leaders per retreat) will lead your Confirmation retreat.

WHERE ARE RETREATS LOCATED?

We will travel to your parish to facilitate your retreat.

WHAT SPACES ARE USED IN THE PARISH?

Ideally the entire parish is blocked off to use for the retreat. The main sessions and meals would happen in the hall/basement/large space. Hallways and welcome area may be used for challenges and games. The church proper would be used for prayer moments.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF THE PARISH?

The parish is responsible to have enough volunteers/parents present to meet your Diocesan youth to adult ratio, provide the meal and/or snacks, and find priests for Reconciliation.

WHAT WILL FACETOFACE PROVIDE?

FacetoFace brings a sound system, projector for videos, and lights, provides all the supplies needed for the retreat, and facilitates all the up-front ministry for the retreat.

WHAT ARE THE RETREAT LENGTH OPTIONS?

Though a full-day is preferred for better preparation, both full-day (5-6 hours on the weekend) or half-day (2-2.5 hours on a weekday evening) options are available.

DOES THE RETREAT INCLUDE RECONCILIATION?

Your retreat schedule typically includes Reconciliation, but your parish can request not to.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Retreat costs vary on length and location. Please contact us for a quote.
